Heavy menstruation is bleeding that lasts longer than 7 days or the amount of blood is greater than 100 ml per cycle. In addition to various hormonal imbalances, disorders of the reproductive organs (ovarian dysfunction, endometriosis, fibroids...), the reasons for heavy menstrual bleeding can also be diseases of other organs, such as diabetes, thyroid gland dysfunction, various autoimmune, kidney diseases. Abundant bleeding can introduce the body into anemia and thus impair important metabolic functions, increase the tendency to infections, and can lead to the development of chronic diseases.

Abundant menstruation should not be neglected and a gynecologist's examination is necessary in order to discover the cause of menorrhagia, as well as its elimination or therapy. The very process of establishing a diagnosis, as well as the effect of therapy, can take time, so it is necessary for patients to use adequate disposable sanitary napkins and pads like Always Platinum sanitary pads and panty pads .
